



Sanitation & Hygiene: Initiatives taken in a State Dispensary


- With the objective to ensure adherence to infection control practices and provide a clean experience to patients and visitors at Baghara State Dispensary, Baghara GP of Bhurbandha Block, DPMU, Morigaon.
- A systematic process of IEC & Capacity Building activities was planned in collaboration with the administrators & staffs of the Dispensary & locals
- Under SHS-2018 (Swachhta Hi Seva), a cleanliness drive was conducted in the month of September 2018, with emphasis on waste segregation & safe disposal with the Dispensary
- > It was followed by a two-day program including orientation on waste management among the stakeholders and a cleanliness drive in teh month of December 2018
- In the absence of advanced waste management facilities, the Dispensary is presently using a concrete Deep Burial Pit for waste disposal after segregation
- > The administrators of the Dispensary have planned to install facilities such as incinerators, Autoclaving, etc. in the future
- The Baghara State Dispensary has also won 1st position at District Level & 2nd position in State Level categories presented by KAYAKALP, an initiative under Ministry of Health And Family Welfare to appreciate and recognise efforts in promoting cleanliness and enhance the quality of public health facilities
