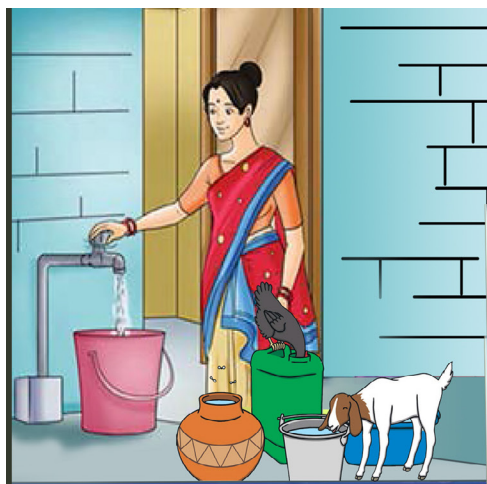

Madam, what are you doing? The clean water from the tap is getting polluted. Just look at those flies and animals around your pots and buckets.

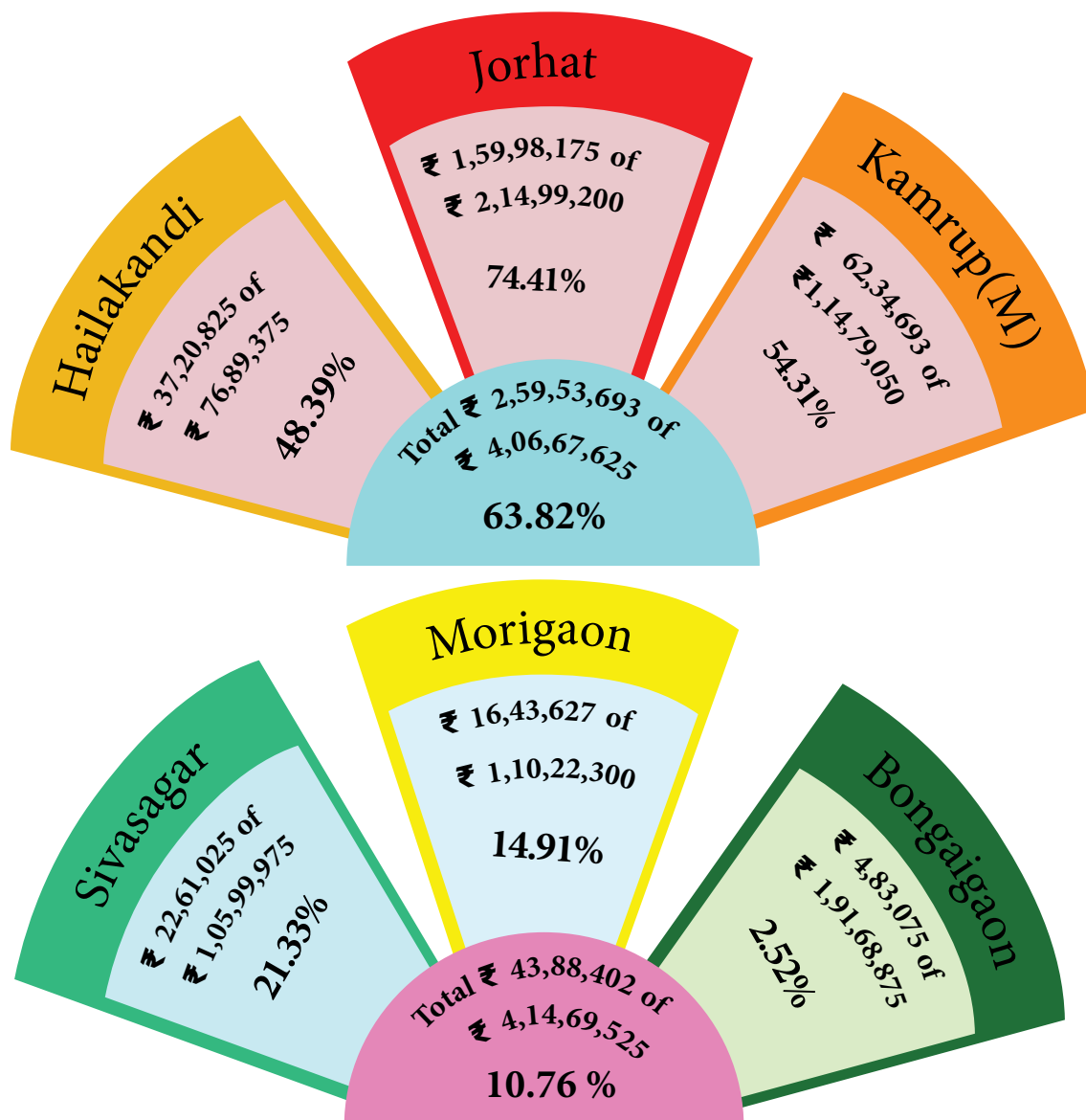


Water should always be kept in clean utensils and covered.

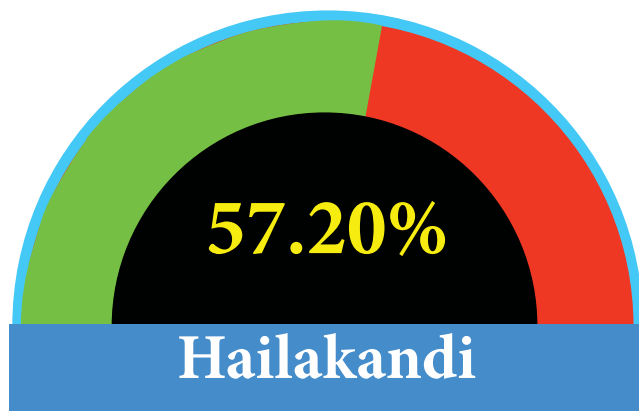
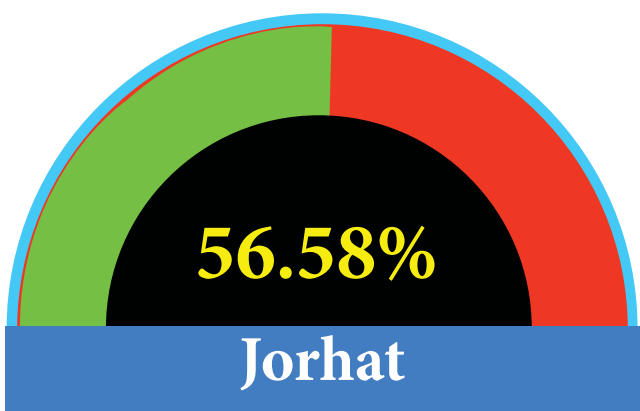
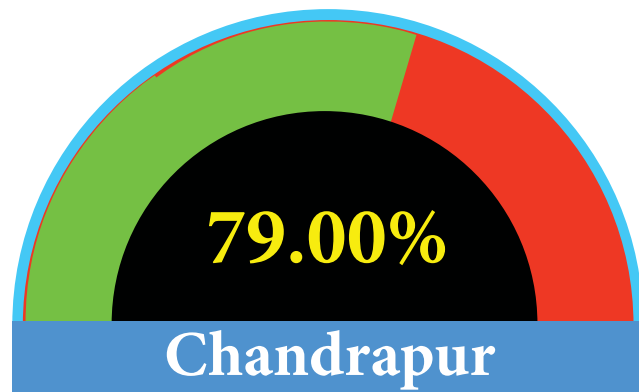
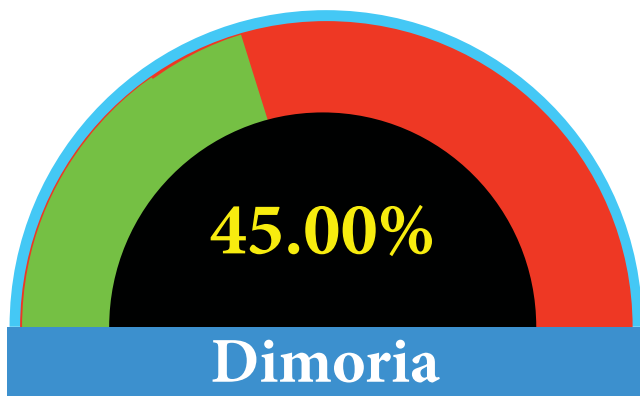
